<p><i>Linguistic</i> Participate in two character debates Use dialogue in reading and writing Play word puzzle games</p>	<p><i>Logical-Mathematical</i> Create timelines of events Use Venn diagrams for comparison Play games to form words using dice with letters</p>
<p><i>Spatial</i> Draw or build settings Create posters of grammar rules Write concrete poems</p>	<p><i>Musical</i> Write and sing songs Associate rhythms with different characters Read and write tongue twisters</p>
<p><i>Intrapersonal</i> Keep logs of silent reading Allow for self-assessment of strengths and challenges Read aloud to a stuffed animal</p>	<p><i>Bodily-Kinesthetic</i> Role play story or act out spelling words Play Simon Says with word actions Make letters with clay, paint, or sand</p>
<p><i>Interpersonal</i> Participate in choral reading or Reader's Theatre Hold mock talk shows Share writing through the Author's Chair or an "Open Mic" night at your classroom café</p>	<p><i>Naturalist</i> Hold Read and Write Outside Days Go on a nature walk for a prewriting activity Create a natural habitat to demonstrate understanding of reading</p>
